#### Developments in international trade and industrial production

- January 2015: world trade down 1.4% month on month, following a 1.3% increase in December.
- January 2015: world industrial production down 0.3% month on month, following a 0.6% increase
  in December.

#### World trade volume

Based on preliminary data, the volume of world trade declined 1.4% in January from the previous month, following a revised 1.3% rise in December (initial estimate: 0.9%). There was a large negative turn-around in emerging economies' import volume growth. Growth turned negative in all major emerging country groups, the largest fall occurring in Asia. Import growth decelerated in advanced economies as well, but remained positive due to accelerations in Japan and the Euro Area. At the export side, the decline was spread more evenly across advanced economies and emerging economies. Most regional sub-indices declined, the exceptions being those for Japan, Central and Eastern Europe, and Latin America.

Because of the volatility of monthly trade figures, momentum is the preferred measure of trade growth.  $^1$  Trade momentum was 0.6% in January (non-annualised), down from 1.3% in December. In advanced economies, import momentum was up, while export momentum was down from the previous month. In emerging economies it was the other way round. In Japan, export momentum climbed to its highest since September 2011. A considerable loss of import momentum occurred in emerging Asia.

#### World industrial production

According to preliminary data, world industrial production declined 0.3% in January, following a revised 0.6% increase in December (initial estimate: 0.4%). Production continued growing in advanced economies, whereas production declined in emerging economies. While results were rather mixed across advanced economies, the decline in emerging economies was widespread.


Global production momentum was 1.0% in January (non-annualised), after recording 1.1% in December. (The longer-term average is 0.7% per three months.) In advanced economies momentum changed little, with the exception of a strong rise in Japan. Momentum fell in most emerging blocks, the exception being Asia.




### **WORLD MERCHANDISE TRADE, CHART 1**



### **WORLD MERCHANDISE TRADE, CHART 2**








