Subject: CPB World Trade Monitor May 2015

Developments in international trade and industrial production

- May 2015: world trade down 1.2% month on month, following a 0.2% decrease in April.
- May 2015: world industrial production down 0.2% month on month, following a 0.1% rise in April.

World trade volume

Based on preliminary data, the volume of world trade contracted 1.2% in May from the previous month, following a revised 0.2% decline in April (initial estimate: +0.3%). The decline was widespread, import and export volumes decreasing in most regions and countries, both advanced and emerging. Import and export growth turned heavily negative in Japan. Among emerging economies, Central and Eastern Europe was one of the worst performers.

Because of the volatility of monthly trade figures, momentum is the preferred measure of trade growth. Trade momentum was -1.3% in May (non-annualised), down from -1.2% in April and the lowest reading since May 2009. Import and export momentum were close to zero in advanced economies, while both numbers were below minus 2% in emerging economies.

World industrial production


According to preliminary data, world industrial production fell 0.2% in May, following a 0.1% increase in April (unchanged from the initial estimate). In advanced economies production contracted for a fourth month in a row, whereas in emerging economies growth was steady at roughly half its long-term average rate.

Global production momentum was zero in May, down from 0.2% in April. Momentum remained positive in emerging economies, but it turned negative in advanced economies. The overall decline originated mainly in Japan and the Euro Area.



¹ Momentum is the change in the three months average up to the report month relative to the average of the preceding three months.


WORLD MERCHANDISE TRADE, CHART 1






INDUSTRIAL PRODUCTION VOLUME, CHART 1
